This year's event will take place over 1 day only on Saturday, August 30th, although we envision this tournament to grow into a full 2 day event in the coming years. 26 total teams across 4 divisions will square off on 13 mats for the duals. 5 rounds of non-stop action packed duals resulting in the first ever Tyrant Nationals Duals champions. We'll wrestle on 16 mats for the Open individual tournament that follows the Duals awards.


18 States are represented by the competitors including:



Tyrant National Duals High School Pool B




Some quick notes about a few things to look out for in the high school division.




