
2025 TUSSLE DUALS TOURNAMENT PREVIEW

HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION

(Accomplishments provided by team coaches) Follow us on social media as we highlight top performances throughout the weekend.

The Tussle Duals HS division is going to be action-packed all weekend long. Numerous talented wrestlers from all over the region & beyond will be competing, some with national level accomplishments. Be on the lookout for tough incoming freshmen who are looking to build momentum into their first high school season. 20 HS teams comprise the division. Each will wrestle 8 duals. 4 pools of 5 teams will determine the 4 team Gold Pool and other Silver etc. pools.

HS Duals Preview

Whatever lineup **The Compound** brings to the mat, it's going to be loaded. There's a good chance we could see nationally recognized talents like **Bo Bassett, Sam Herring, Melvin Miller, Keegan Bassett** in action, though lineups are never guaranteed. Either way, their reputation speaks for itself, as most of these athletes are already accomplished on the biggest youth and high school stages. Other names to keep an eye out for include Owen McMullen, Jackson Butler, CJ Pensiero, the list goes on! One star we know won't be in the mix is **Jax Forrest**, who will be overseas representing Team USA at the Senior World Championships — a testament to just how high-level this program really is. With firepower from the lightweights up through the upper weights, The Compound is positioning themselves as one of the most dangerous squads in the field and is the #1 seed.

Garnett Trained rolls into the Tussle with one of the deepest, most credentialed rosters in the entire field. This squad is loaded with state champions and nationally ranked names. The front end features Indiana Triple Crown winner Sam Rioux (98) and New York state champion Wyatt Sartori (106), immediately setting the tone. At 113, Jackson Shipley (TX State Champ, NR#20) adds national recognition, while Deklan Barr (PA State Placer, NHSCA Champion) and Aiden Ohl (OH State Champion) bolster the middleweights. Depth continues with multiple proven placers like Braiden Weaver (PA State 3rd), Brock Beckler (OH State 5th), and PA state qualifier Kam Borrero (144). The

upperweights are just as stacked — Gunner Gossett (OH State Finalist) at 157, Brodie Melzoni (TN State Champ) at 165, and Jake Hughes (OH State 3rd) at 175. The upperweights are highlighted by Michael White (IN State Champ, NR#3), with Malaki Washington (WV State Finalist) and Knox McKibben (OH State 5th) adding depth and toughness. With star power across nearly every weight, Garnett Trained isn't just entering this tournament — they're coming in as one of the clear squads to beat and they'll be the 2 seed.

Freakztyle Wrestling – The #3 Seed. The lightweights are dangerous out of the gate with Griffin Smith (2x WV State Champ, 98) and Bryce Thomas (106, SW Regional placer), followed closely by a lethal 113-pound duo of Chad Artman (3x WV State Champ) and Kellen Weaver (PJW State Runner-Up, Keystone State Champ). At 120, Tommy Gretz (6th at PIAA States) adds proven depth, while Braden Wivell (126, PIAA SQ) and Cael Yanek (132, PIAA SQ) keep the middleweights strong. It continues with Drake McClure (138, PIAA 8th) and Lucas Barr (144, 3x PIAA SQ), two battle-tested wrestlers with postseason credentials. From 150 through 175, Julian Bertucci (PIAA SQ), Eli Tedrow (WV State Champ), and Liam Costa (PIAA SQ) provide depth and toughness. Emery Johnson (190, PIAA SQ, I-90 Champion) leads the way, while Gary Kiselka (215, PIAA SQ) and Colton Tupper (215, I-90 Champion)

Top Level – The #4 seed in HS. They open with AJ Pifer (98, PA Youth State Champ) setting the tone. Adding to their Pennsylvania core, Braxton Shaffer (MI HS State Placer, 113) brings proven out-of-state

firepower. The middle of the order is loaded with hammers: Dylan Barrett (120, 3x PA HS State Qualifier, 2025 State 7th) and Cam Baker (126, 3x PA HS State Placewinner) bring high-level postseason experience, while Marco Hutcherson (126, 4x PA Youth State Champ) adds more firepower at the same weight. At 144 and 150, Ben Murphy and Luke Boyer (2x PA SQ, 2025 5th at States) continue the run of battle-tested competitors. The upperweights are anchored by serious talent — Mario Hutcherson (190, 2025 PIAA 6th, Fargo National Champ) and Cooper Roscosky (215, 2x PA State Placewinner, 2025 Runner-Up) give Top Level a powerful 1-2 punch, with Philup Rearick (285, 2025 PA State Placewinner) providing a heavyweight closer capable of sealing duals. Across the board, this is a squad with balance, credentials, and enough firepower to challenge anyone in the field.

Set up for the tournament has begun and we're still trying to process the amount of talented wrestlers across all age levels that will be competing this weekend! Needless to say we are excited to see what all the teams and wrestlers have in store for us! Stay tuned for more insights, breakdowns, key matchups etc.
