If you're looking for standout showdowns and high-level wrestling, you're in the right place. Tyrant Wrestling is back in the Sunshine State gearing up for another electric weekend here at the 5th annual Poseidon Duals & Open. Athletes from at least **21 different states**—including **FL, GA, AL, NC, SC, TN, VA, WV, PA, NJ, NY, MD, MI, IN, IL, OK, LA, TX, KS, NM, and CO**—are bringing their best to test their skills this weekend. 57 dual teams across 4 divisions are set to square off on 28 mats!

Overall, approximately 800 wrestlers will be competing in the duals and 800+ wrestlers are registered for the Open tournament!

# Poseidon Duals Preview

*(Accomplishments provided by team coaches) We will highlight top performances throughout the weekend on social media!*

The High School division will feature many of Florida's most elite wrestlers. State champs, state placers, tough 8th graders, as well as countless other wrestlers looking to take their skills to the next level this offseason. 24 HS teams will compete in 4 pools of 6 on Saturday with each pool winner advancing to Sunday's Gold Pool to determine the Champion. The MS & ES6 divisions each contain 12 teams and will compete in 2 pools of 6 with the top 8 teams going into a reseeded Gold Bracket. The ES4 division will wrestle in a round robin format with 9 total teams.

**Spec Ops** The 2024 Poseidon Duals Champs are the #1 seed in the HS div. coming into the weekend. If you're looking for firepower at every weight class, this team brings it.

They have a mix of multiple-time **FHSAA State Champions, Fargo All-Americans, and Super 32 winners.** Gladiator Alliance is built for gold. If they hit their stride, they could run the table.
